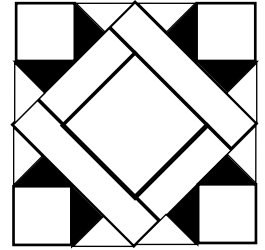


HAZEL'S DIARY BONUS BLOCK

ROYAL STAR

12" FINISHED BLOCK



This block is being offered as an alternate star block, in the event you do not wish to use the Corn and Beans block (or any one of the other blocks) in your Hazel's Diary 1951 quilt.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

From Fabric #1, cut:

One square $4 \frac{3}{4}$ " x $4 \frac{3}{4}$ "

From Fabric #3, cut:

Two squares $4 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $4 \frac{1}{4}$ ", then cut these twice on the diagonal to make a total of 8 triangles

From Fabric #4 (background), cut:

Two squares $4 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $4 \frac{1}{4}$ ", then cut these twice on the diagonal to make a total of 8 triangles

Four squares $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $3 \frac{1}{2}$ "

From Fabric #6, cut:

Two rectangles $2 \frac{5}{8}$ " x $4 \frac{3}{4}$ "

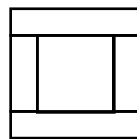
Two rectangles $2 \frac{5}{8}$ " x 9"

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

To two opposite sides of the Fabric #1 square, stitch a short Fabric #6 rectangle. Press seams toward Fabric #6.



Add the long Fabric #6 rectangles to the other two sides of the Fabric #1 square.



Next, divide your triangles into sets of four, so that there are two piles of four Fabric #4 triangles, and two piles of four Fabric #3 triangles. Lay two piles out together like this:



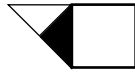
And two piles out together like this:



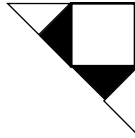
Join these pairs together along the short sides to create units that look like this (you should have four of each configuration):



Next, sew a Fabric #4 square to the triangle unit's Fabric #6 side, as shown.

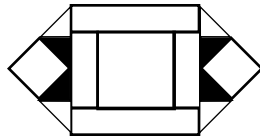


Add the opposite unit to the other side of the square.



Make four units like this.

Add one to each side of the center unit.



And one to the top and bottom to complete the block.
