

Maple Leaf Layout #3

This layout is a bit smaller and easier than the previous ones. It makes a table runner measuring 12 3/4" wide by 42 1/2". You can certainly make it longer simply by adding more leaves, squares, and setting triangles.

You don't even need a chart for this one, it's so easy!

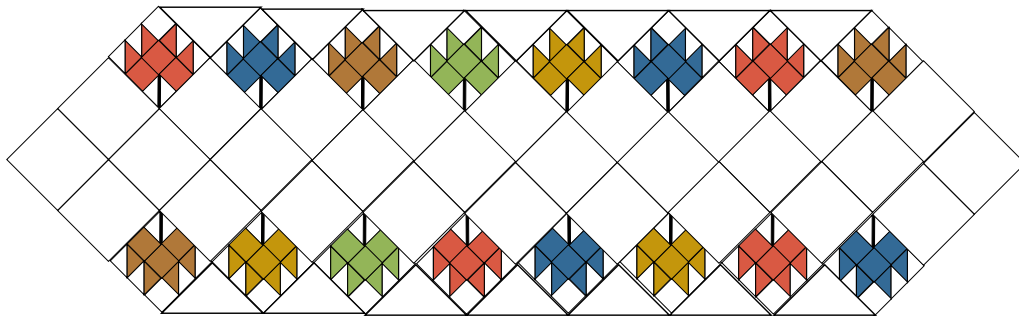
To make it as shown, you will need:

16 Maple Leaf blocks

28 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

4 squares 6 1/4" x 6 1/4" Cut these squares in half twice on the diagonal to make a total of 16 triangles. You'll have two left over unused.

Simply sew all the pieces together in diagonal rows, then sew the rows together.



Here's another option . . .

Just put a row of leaves down the middle!

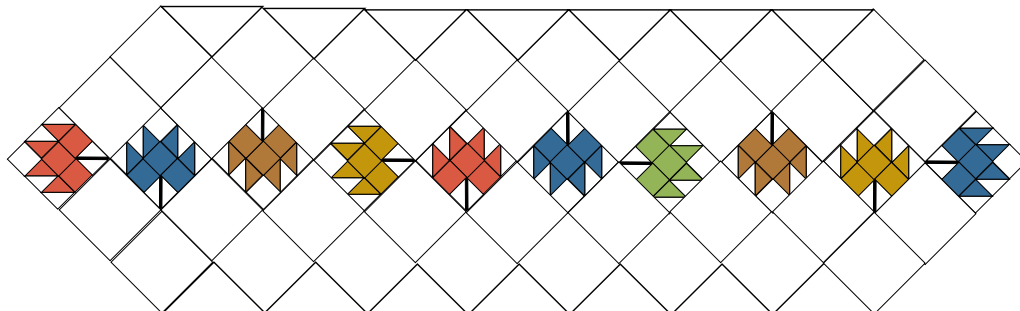
To make this one, you'll need:

10 Maple Leaf blocks

34 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

4 squares 6 1/4" x 6 1/4" Cut these squares in half twice on the diagonal to make a total of 16 triangles. You'll have two left over unused.

Again, it's simply sewn together in diagonal rows.



I'll bet you can think of several other configurations of leaves and squares for making a table runner like this. Perfect for fall, and you still have time to whip one up for THIS fall!
