

# Prairie Moon Quilts

## Longarm Quilting Service

Hand guided non-computerized quilting on an Innova M24

### Basic All-Over Designs

Medium all-over meander:

\$0.015 per square inch

Smaller stippling:

\$0.02 per square inch

Minimum charge \$25

### Pantograph Designs

Single moderately-spaced edge-to-edge patterns sewn in rows across the quilt:

\$0.025 per square inch

Denser, more intricate designs:

\$0.03 per square inch

Minimum charge \$30

### Custom: Easy

Freehand custom stitching that does not require the use of any special tools other than a straight-edged ruler, requires no marking, and is not dense coverage:

Starts at \$0.04 per square inch

Minimum charge \$50

### Custom: Medium

Freehand custom stitching that requires marking, ruler or template work, turning in the frame, and/or thread color changes, with moderately dense coverage:

Starts at \$0.05 per square inch

Minimum charge \$75

### Custom: Heirloom

Detailed custom quilting. Customized/individual block designs, complex borders/sashings, use of stencils/marking designs, intricate template or ruler work, micro stippling or dense background fills.

Designs must be discussed with customer in detail:

Starts at \$0.06 per square inch. Minimum charge \$100

### Additional Costs and Services

#### Thread:

There is no extra charge for thread. I use primarily Superior OMNI thread (40 wt. 2-ply poly-wrapped poly core thread) because that's what my machine prefers. It comes in lots of colors and in variegated as well, so there are options. I don't use monofilament or metallic threads in my machine. Bobbin thread is matched to top thread unless otherwise specified.

#### Batting:

You may provide your own batting of choice, or purchase batting from me. I provide the following choices:

Quilter's Dream Poly Select white: \$12.00 per yard from the roll, or the current rate for packaged batting.

Quilter's Dream Cotton Select natural: \$15.50 per yard from the roll, or the current rate for packaged batting.

I can also provide any other Quilter's Dream batting.

#### Backing:

Your backing must measure at least 8" - 12" larger than your quilt top. When possible, if you must piece your backing, piece it so that the seams run parallel to the quilt frame rollers. I'd be happy to discuss that with you ahead of time, if necessary. I can prepare backing for your quilt using fabric you provide. You need to provide enough fabric so that, once pieced, it will measure 8" - 12" larger than your quilt top. I charge \$5 per seam to piece your backing for you. I will press your backing before loading it on the quilting frame at no extra charge.

My frame can accommodate a backing up to 122" wide, so your quilt top would need to be 114" wide or less for me to be able to fit it on my frame.

Trimming: \$20

Binding: (prices apply to straight binding only)

Preparing binding from your fabric: \$10.00

Machine sewing binding to top of quilt: \$25.00

Hand stitching to back side of quilt: \$0.12 per linear inch

Specialty bindings on request. I do not do machine binding because I'm not good at it!

Hanging Sleeve:

Hanging sleeve with a 4" opening prepared from your provided fabric, and ready for you to stitch to the back of your quilt: \$20

Attached to the quilt for you: add \$27

My longarm machine is an Innova M24. It has a stitch regulator, but it is NOT computerized. I do all my quilting freehand or with the aid of rulers. I do not mark on a quilt top with anything other than white chalk without prior approval. I do not spray water on quilts.

Contact me to receive an emailed PDF catalog of my available pantograph designs. If you don't see anything you like in the catalog, I am willing to purchase any other design you like, as long as I am able to correctly execute it with my non-computerized machine.

Quilting charges are based on size of the quilt top in square inches and do not include the cost of backing, batting, or other additional services. Prices are subject to change without notice. Written estimates are valid for 60 days. To estimate what it will cost to get your quilt quilted, use the following formula:

Length of quilt x Width of quilt = Square Inches

Square Inches x Quilting Rate for type of quilting desired = Cost of Quilting

Cost of Quilting + Cost of any Additional Services = Total Cost

Payment is due when quilt is returned. I accept cash, checks, money orders, or PayPal payments.

To book a slot for your quilt, check the web site ([prairiemoonquilts.com/quiltin/my-schedule/](http://prairiemoonquilts.com/quiltin/my-schedule/)) for my current availability and to see open time slots. We can also discuss your time frame and deadlines when you're ready to book a slot or send me your quilt top. If you don't have your quilt to me by the time of your scheduled slot, you will lose your place in line.
